

What is the Emergency Medical Treatment Form?

Metro Fire provides a form for citizens to fill out that will give firefighters important information to treat you in a medical emergency at your home.

How Can Firefighters Find the Form?

In the event Metro Fire firefighters are in your home during an emergency, they will check the front of the refrigerator for your Emergency Medical Treatment Form. Post the filled-in form on the front of your refrigerator using tape, sticker or a magnet. For privacy, the bottom of the form can be folded up just underneath the fire department logo; make sure the logo still shows.

How Often Should I Update the Form?

You should update your Emergency Medical Treatment Form annually or any time your medical information changes.



Fill Out the Emergency Medical Treatment Form

- Fill in name, age, address and other identifying information.
- List medical insurance information.
- Write in appropriate medical history.
- Write in names of your medication and your allergies.
- Select 1st, 2nd, 3rd hospital preferences for transport.
- Name person you want contacted in case of emergency.

Place the Form on the Front of the Refrigerator

The front of your refrigerator is highly visible, firefighters who are not familiar with your home can quickly, and easily find the form if it is in the same place at every home.

Metro Fire respects your privacy and information provided on the form will only be used as State Law allows.



Hospital Preference Choice

If you need to be taken to the hospital, firefighters want to know your first, second and third choice. Emergency room closure, over-capacity, and/or road closure may present a situation where your hospital preference choice cannot be honored.
