Thank you for agreeing to be a part of the development of the Sacramento Metro Fire Community Wildfire Protection Plan, or CWPP. The CWPP is intended to help agencies, communities and local homeowners define, plan and prioritize types of actions that will limit the damage associated with the inevitable wildland fire event.

Metro Fire is convening a group of interested stakeholders to provide input on the development of Metro Fire's CWPP. The stakeholder process will involve a series of three meetings over the course of the next two months. The first meeting of this group will be convened from 2:00 - 4:00 PM on **October 11, 2013** at the Sacramento Metropolitan Fire District Headquarters offices located at 10545 Armstrong Ave., Ste. 200, Mather, CA 95655.

Through the stakeholder process, Metro Fire would like to obtain your feedback on content of critical components of the CWPP including the Community Base Map, description of existing conditions, the risks posed by wildfire within the District, projects that improve the current condition, and priority of those projects.

At the meeting on October 11, 2013, Metro Fire intends to introduce you to the CWPP process, identify Metro Fire's goals for the plan, and to initiate review and solicitation of input on the Community Base Map and definition of the wildland-urban interface (WUI) boundary within Metro Fire's service area.

At subsequent meetings, we will present additional components of the CWPP that we will seek your input on the form and content. We anticipate the next meeting will be held around mid-November 2013.
