## California Car Seat Law

**Effective January 1, 2017:** Children under 2 years of age must ride in a rear-facing car seat unless the child weighs 40 or more pounds OR is 40 or more inches tall. Children under the age of 8 must be secured in a car seat or booster seat in the back seat. Children who are 8 years of age OR have reached 4'9" in height must be secured by a safety belt. Passengers who are 16 years of age and over are subject to California's mandatory Seat Belt law.
