## FIRE SAFETY DURING CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION: SITE SAFETY PLAN

In accordance with Section 3303.1 of the 2022 CA Fire Code, the owner or owner's authorized agent shall be responsible for the development, implementation and maintenance of an approved, written site safety plan establishing a fire prevention program at the project site applicable throughout all phases of the **construction**, **repair**, **alteration or demolition** work. The plan shall be submitted and approved before a building permit is issued. Any changes to the plan shall be submitted for approval. Include this form with the plan submittal through the Fire Prevention Mobile Portal.

1. What training has the site safety director and fire watch personnel completed to qualify themselves for this position?

4. What are the locations of fire protection equipment, including portable fire extinguishers, standpipes, fire department connections and fire hydrants? A site/floor plan may be attached.

5. What are the smoking and cooking policies, designated areas to be used where approved, and signage locations in accordance with Section 3305.8?

6. Will temporary heating equipment be used on site? Indicate location and safety considerations for temporary heating equipment. A site/floor plan may be attached.

7. Will there be hot works on site? What is the hot work permit plan?

- 8. What is the plan for control of combustible waste material?
- 9. Indicate locations and methods for storage and use of flammable and combustible liquids and other hazardous materials. A site/floor plan may be attached.

10. What are the provisions for site security?

11. Are there any foreseen changes that will affect this plan?

12. Indicate any other site-specific information that is pertinent for fire code official to be aware of.
